



More tenants confirmed for The Banks

Developers behind The Banks confirmed today the names of three additional tenants that have signed leases for retail space at the riverfront development.

They include:

- Huey's 24/7 Diner – a diner open round-the-clock that will offer traditional diner fare along with Big Easy favorites such as shrimp etouffee, jambalaya and red beans & rice. www.hueys247diner.com

- La Crepe Nanou – a romantic neighborhood bistro that will offer traditional French fare including signature crepes, cheese fondue, salads and moules frites. www.lacrepenanou.com

- Wine Loft – An upscale wine bar offering 70 wines by the glass and over 250 wines by the bottle. The Wine Loft also offers spirits, beers, and international cuisine. www.thewineloft.net

Last month, The Enquirer reported that Louisiana-based Doyle Restaurant Group had planned to open each of the venues at The Banks. The developers news today confirms the deals.

"These announcements further our plan to create a fun place that's always happening and offers something for everyone," said Trent Germano, The Banks' developer in a news release. "Each concept brings a unique experience that when combined will create a dynamic, entertaining and fun place to be."

When combined with Toby Keith's I Love This Bar & Grill and the Holy Grail — two tenants already confirmed by the development team – the leased space at The Banks first phase now totals nearly 32,000 square feet or roughly one third of the first phase retail space.
