the free-heated-underground parking.

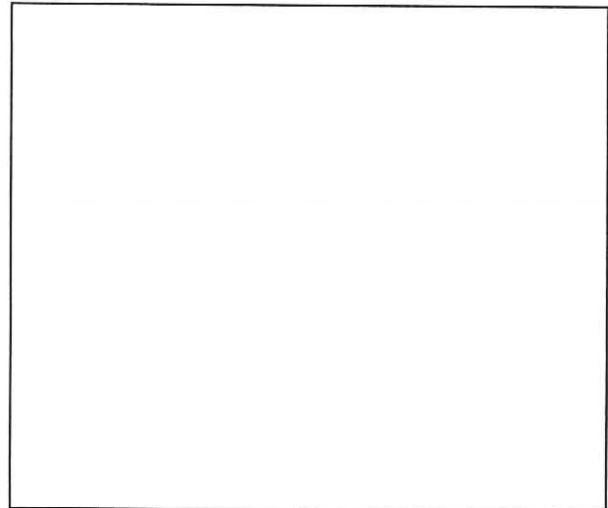
"I hear a lot from actual downtown residents, that they'd just assume jump in their car and shoot up 394 and come over here for free parking," said Landstad.
